As Chair of the Yukon Chamber of Commerce, I would like to extend an invitation for you to come to the Yukon to meet with our Business owners to hear our suggestions and concerns about your government's proposed small business tax changes.

With the Yukon private sector comprised almost entirely of small businesses, the Yukon and the other northern Territories are impacted by the proposed changes.
